Fabric Requirements

1 yard Winter-C4629 Winter
1/3 yard Winter-C4631 Ice
1/3 yard Winter-C4632 Leaf
1/3 yard Winter-C4633 Tree
1 1/4 yards Winter-C4634 Snow
5/8 yard Studio-C3096 Navy
3/4 yard Studio-C3096 Sky
5/8 yard Winter-C4630 Water (binding)
3 1/2 yards backing fabric of your choice
61" x 75" batting

Cutting

From Winter-C4629 Winter:

- Cut one 30 1/2" x 40 1/2" rectangle for the quilt center, positioning the design as desired.

From Winter-C4631 Ice:

Cut one 8 1/2" x width-of-fabric (WOF) strip. Sub-cut four 6 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles.

From Winter-C4632 Leaf:

- Cut one 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut one 8 1/2" x 30 1/2" strip.

From Winter-C4633 Tree:

- Cut one 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut one 8 1/2" x 30 1/2" strip.

From Winter-C4634 Snow:

- Cut two 6 1/2" x length-of-fabric (LOF) strips. Trim each strip to 6 1/2" x 40 1/2".

From Studio-C3096 Navy:

- Cut twelve 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut one strip into four 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips, and each of two strips into a 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" strip.

From Studio-C3096 Sky:

Cut six 3 1/2" x WOF strips for borders.

From Winter-C4630 Water:

Cut seven 2 1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

Quilt Top Assembly

Note that some prints are directional, so refer to the quilt photo for orientation.

1. Sew one 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" C3096 Navy strip to each side of C4629 Winter rectangle.
2. Sew one 6 1/2" x 40 1/2" C4634 Snow strip to each side of the step 1 unit.
3. Sew nine 1 1/2" x WOF C3096 Navy strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the width of the step 2 unit through the center and cut two strips that measurement. Sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the step 2 unit to create the center section. (figure 1)

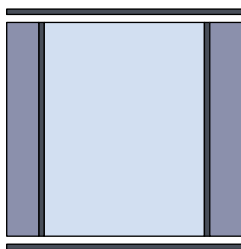

4. Sew one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" C3096 Navy strip to each side of the 8 1/2" x 30 1/2" C4633 Tree strip.
5. Sew one 6 1/2" x 8 1/2" C4631 Ice rectangle to each end of the

step 4 unit to create the top row. (figure 2) Sew the top row to center section created in step 3.

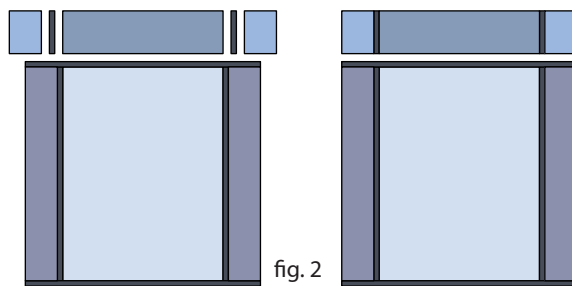

6. Sew one 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" C3096 Navy strip to each side of the 8 1/2" x 30 1/2" C4632 Leaf strip.

7. Sew one 6 1/2" x 8 1/2" C4631 Ice rectangle to each end of the step 6 unit to create the bottom row. (figure 3) Sew the bottom row to the center section.

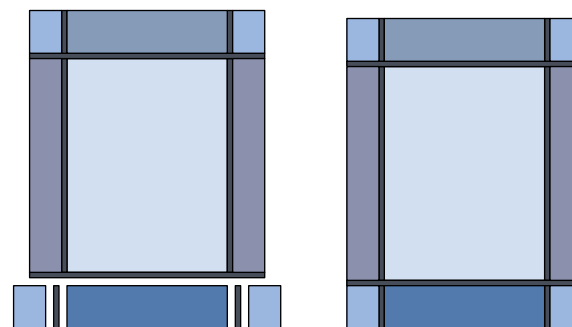

8. Measure the quilt length through the center and cut two strips that measurement from the remaining 1 1/2" C3096 Navy strip. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.

9. Measure the quilt width through the center and cut two strips to that measurement from the 1 1/2" C3096 Navy strip. Sew one strip to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt.

10. Piece the 3 1/2" x WOF C3096 Sky strips end to end using diagonal seams. Repeat steps 8 and 9 to attach the Sky borders.

Finishing

11. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired.
12. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
13. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.

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
