Making the Border Block


Assemble:

(136) Green Spots, Yellow Spots, Jaguar, and Giraffe QSTs

(136) 1-1/2" × 3" Vanilla rectangles


(32) or (34) 1-1/2" Vanilla squares


Sew a 1-1/2" \times 3" Vanilla rectangle to the left side of a Giraffe QST as shown. Press to the rectangle. Make 32 for the small size and 34 for the large size.






Sew a 1-1/2" \times 3" Vanilla rectangle to the top of a Jaguar QST as shown. Press to the rectangle. Make 32 for the small size and 34 for the large size.







Sew a 1-1/2" \times 3" Vanilla rectangle to the bottom of a Yellow Spots QST as shown. Press to the rectangle. Make 32 for the small size and 34 for the large size.

Sew the 1-1/2" Vanilla square to the top right of the Green Spots unit. Stop sewing in the middle of the block. This is a tiny seam. You may want to backstitch that seam. (See # 1 below left)

Sew a Giraffe unit to the top of that unit, then sew a Yellow Spots unit to the right side. Finally, sew a Jaguar unit along the bottom. Now you can go back and finish the partial seam. Press. Your block should be 6-1/2" square. Make 32 for the small size and 34 for the large size.
